BROW WAXING SYSTEM BY BROWXENNA®

QUESTION

How to remove the residue of wax from the skin?



What should I do if the wax got on the brow?

How to take care of the depilation zone after the procedure?

ANSWER

BrowXenna® wax does not leave any residue on the skin, but if there is any wax left, remove the wax from the skin with BrowXenna® waxing oil after depilation.

If this happens, gently remove the wax from the skin with a cotton pad or a toothpick using BrowXenna® oil after depilation.

After the procedure, apply special care and soothing product. The BrowXenna® line includes post-depilation oil containing menthol, coconut oil and lavender for skin care.

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QUESTION

If it was impossible to remove hairs and/or fluff for the first time, can I apply wax again to the same area?

Do you need to apply wax by the hair growth or against it?

ANSWER

BrowXenna® wax is designed specifically to remove even the toughest of hairs for the first time. But if you're faced with a situation that suggests you need to apply a second coat, you can do so and your skin won't react if you first apply oil to your skin before depilating with BrowXenna®.

BrowXenna® can be applied against hair growth as well as by growth.

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QUESTION

Should I remove wax by hair growth or against it?

At what temperature the wax should be melted?

Does anything have to be applied to the skin before depilation?

ANSWER

Wax should be removed in the opposite direction to the application.

BrowXenna® wax melts at a temperature of 38-40°C, which eliminates the possibility of burns.

For the depilation procedure, clean the skin with BrowXenna® Pre-Waxing Lotion of makeup and impurities and then apply a thin layer of BrowXenna® oil or talcum powder.

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QUESTION

Do the hair ingrow after waxing?

Can waxing damage the skin on my face?

ANSWER

No, the hairs do not ingrow after the procedure.

Wax and BrowXenna® skincare products eliminate the possibility of injury. However, we do not recommend waxing for clients with hypersensitive skin.

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QUESTION

Will the hairs get thicker after waxing?

Is it possible to combine waxing and facial treatments?

ANSWER

No. The hairs tend to grow evenly and do not change their thickness depending on how they are removed.

Many salon treatments, such as peeling, affect the characteristics of the upper layers of the face, making it more sensitive and thinner. This is worth keeping in mind if you want to combine the treatments. Consult your cosmetologist.

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QUESTION

Will the face redden after the procedure?

How long will the hairs grow back after waxing?

ANSWER

BrowXenna® wax and skincare products protect your skin from redness. However, if the redness does occur on sensitive skin, you should wait or use special products. BrowXenna® waxing oil does this job perfectly, it contains menthol and cosmetic oils that will allow the skin to "soothe" quickly.

The hairs removed by waxing begin to grow after two or three weeks, and the correction effect lasts up to eight weeks.

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QUESTION

Is it safe to remove facial hair with wax at home?

How long should the hairs be?

ANSWER

If you take precautions and follow the instructions correctly, such as taking an allergy test, the procedure at home can be safe. The most common mistake in home waxing is burn injuries from hot wax, skin damage or skin reactions from combination with other procedures.

BrowXenna® wax removes hairs as long as 1 mm.

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QUESTION

Can it cause allergies?



ANSWER

BrowXenna® wax is hypoallergenic, so it does not cause allergies. But if you or your client has highly sensitive skin, we recommend that you test the wax on other parts of your body before depilating the face.

The BROW WAXING SYSTEM range also includes a range of skincare products. They contain natural components and oils that can cause allergic reactions of the client in case of individual intolerance.

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QUESTION

Can I use them with inflammation on my face?

What should I use to apply the wax?

Can only be used on the face?

ANSWER

We do not recommend waxing your skin with rashes and inflammation.

Use special spatulas or wax applicators. They can be made of wood or plastic.

BrowXenna® wax can handle hairs not only on the face but also throughout the body.
